PPE Regulated Equipment

Onsite Support is a British Safety Industry Federation (BSIF) registered Safety Supplier. This means we undertake to maintain or verify valid compliance certificates for all PPE and regulated equipment we offer and not knowingly to supply any product which is counterfeit or illegally conformity assessed and marked

We require all our manufacturing partners to provide up to date and independently validate certification for all the products they supply to us. Please refer to appendices below Each year as part of our audit together with the BSIF they randomly select one of our manufacturers' products and have them independently tested.

All our products meet the required EU and UK Standards. The OnSite Support compliance team constantly monitors for both QA and conformity in all categories. Where products are sourced from external organisations which hold technical files we confirm that these are current, complete, contain appropriate conformity assessment information and, where relevant, regulatory compliance certificates and take all necessary steps to confirm the validity of the compliance. This includes safety, environmental, quality, performance and all other standards and legislative requirements.

This is covered by the General Product Safety Regulations 2005 (GPSR) which requires all products to be safe in their normal or reasonably foreseeable usage.

Specifically for PPE we meet the requirements of PPE Regulation 2016/425 by ensuring that for all PPE products imported by us directly or indirectly from UK based manufacturers have correct test and compliance certification and declaration of conformity.

We check that all products carry the correct standards including but not limited to the those for PPE. A list of the most commonly required product standards for PPE can be found in the appendices below.

The overriding legislation is The Personal Protective Equipment at Work (Amendment) Regulations 2022.
